Meeting Commenced: At 7:12 PM with Pres Cliff - Opening remarks and Greetings

Secretary's Report: Dave read minutes of Jan 8/07. M/S Dave/Carl to accept. Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Bruce reported that we have \$4093 in bank, with 33 members paid to date.

Old Business:

Club Crests, Caps and decals – Dave has for sale - costs are \$10, \$16 and \$1.50 @ respectively
Storage Building – Larry has drawn some tentative plans for a 8'x12' shed. Rough estimate of \$500 for wood framing. It wasn't felt that this would be strong enough, so more research is required. Cliff said he could get a Sea-container for \$1000 and then we could cover it with the paneling.

Shed – Tarp for Carport – Cliff has a lead on a new tarp from the Flying Tigers.

Events in 2007 It was suggested that each member would be required to volunteer a minimum of 4 hours in a year. A great idea, but would be a policing nightmare. 11 members present showed they would support the various projects proposed for 2007.

IMAC – Ken June 2 & 3 – no objections from the membership, more to follow, with list of tasks.

SOMA – Aug 18 & 19 - no objections from the membership. A new date will be set.

Big Brother's Day – June 9/10 – Chairman - Dave Trimmer. Several recommendations were made:

1) limit # of trainers in the air to 2 at once. 2) Cordon off pit area to contain spectators. 3) Improve security for the radio impound. 4) We need a firm head count of guests to determine how much supplies to purchase. 5) Keep kids occupied to prevent boredom and mischief, i.e. kits, SIMS, VHS tapes, etc.

Fun Fly – July 14/15 - The Exec. Committee will "host" the event with games and activities.

Liability signs from MAAC – must be in place for any 'public event', such as Big Brothers, IMAC and SOMA.

Standing Resolution #5 – Aerodrome test flights – Ralf will be the only contact to Heli Links to obtain permission to test fly. Review SR #5.

Wind Socks – from Exec. Mike and Cliff will make a "weather vane" for the pole by the driveway, then the flight line pole will be replaced and "Dollar store" windsocks will be placed.

Bulletin Board Cabinet – Carl has obtained some ½" Lexan and will install it. Pres. Cliff thanked Carl for his efforts.
